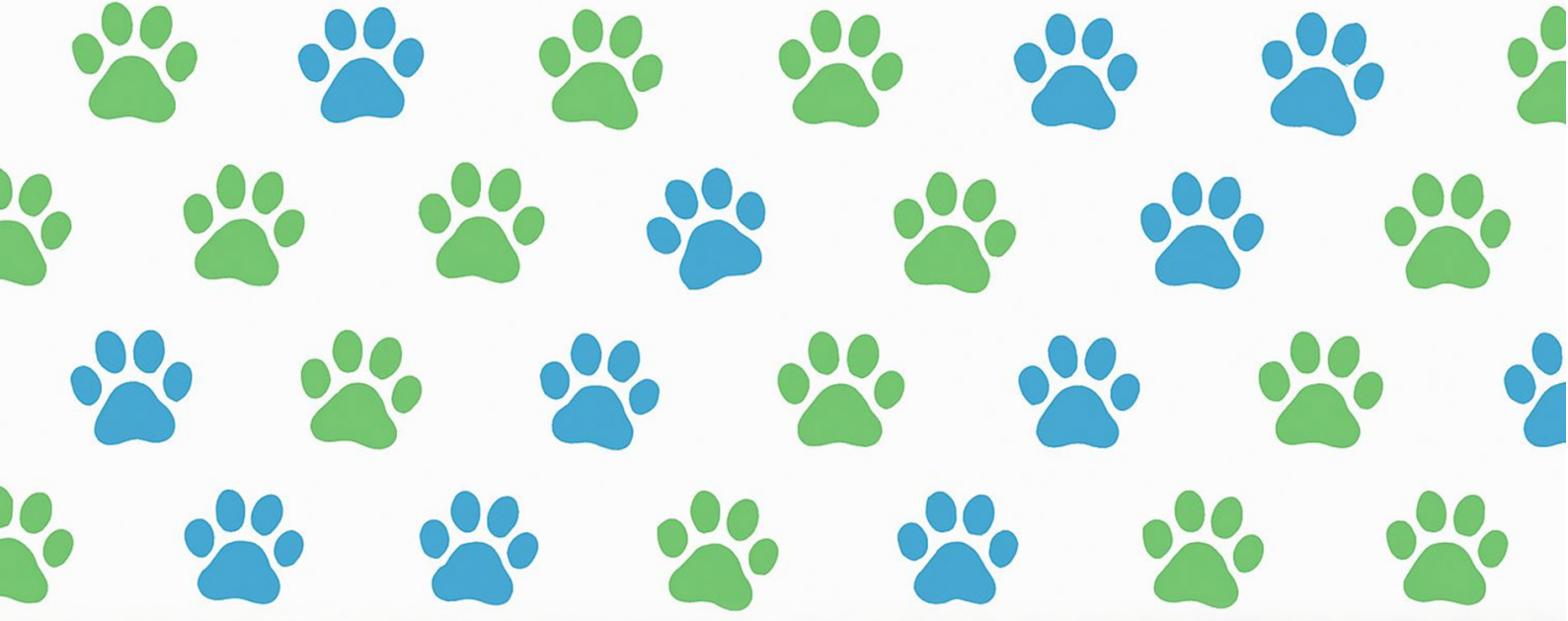




Cody's

“Cody! No!” Lisa shouted when she found a big hole in the garden. But she could only stay upset for a moment — Cody was just too cute.

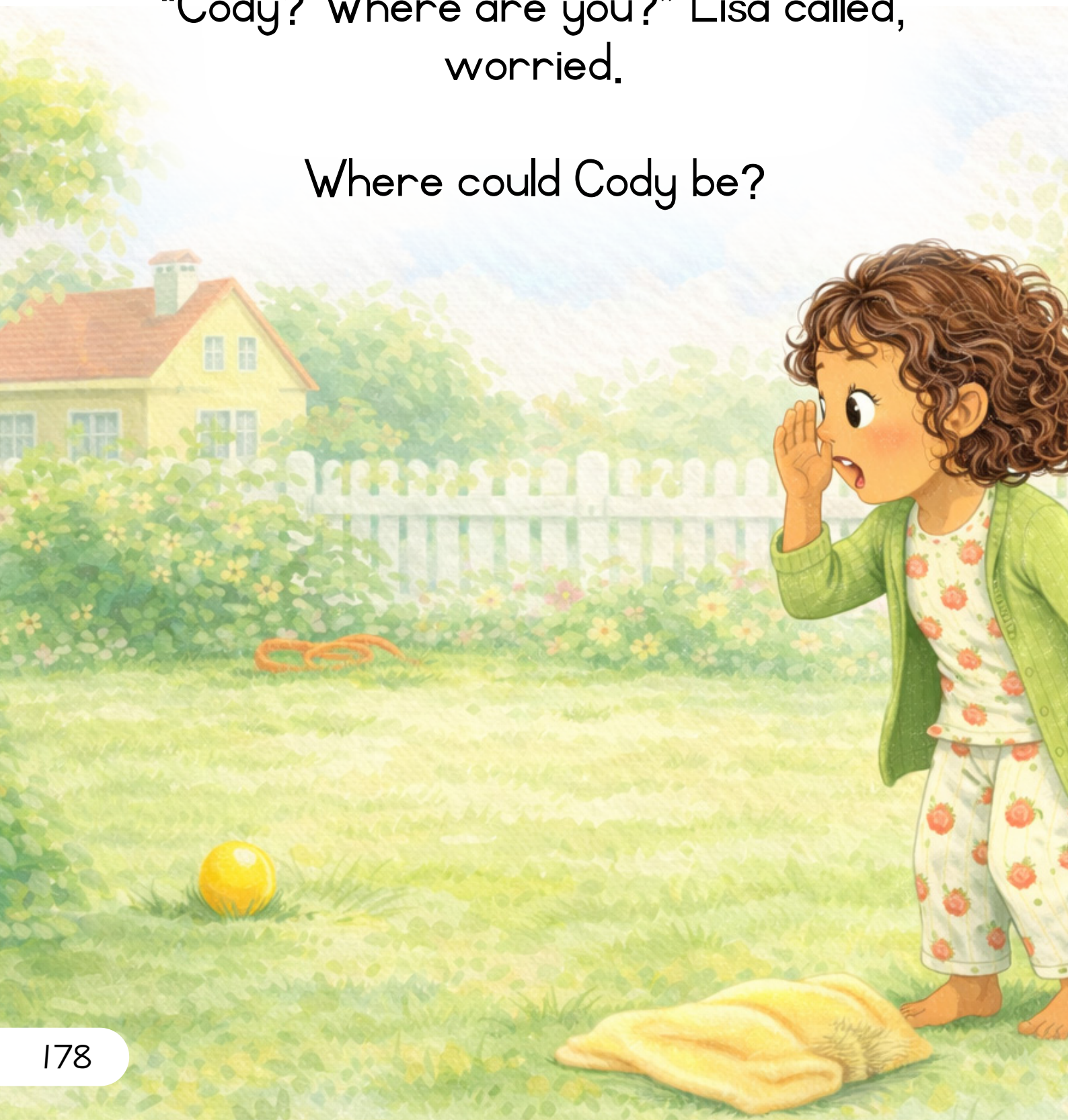
After a long afternoon of playing, it was bath time. Lisa brushed Cody’s fur until it was shiny and clean. She washed his paws and wiped his ears.
