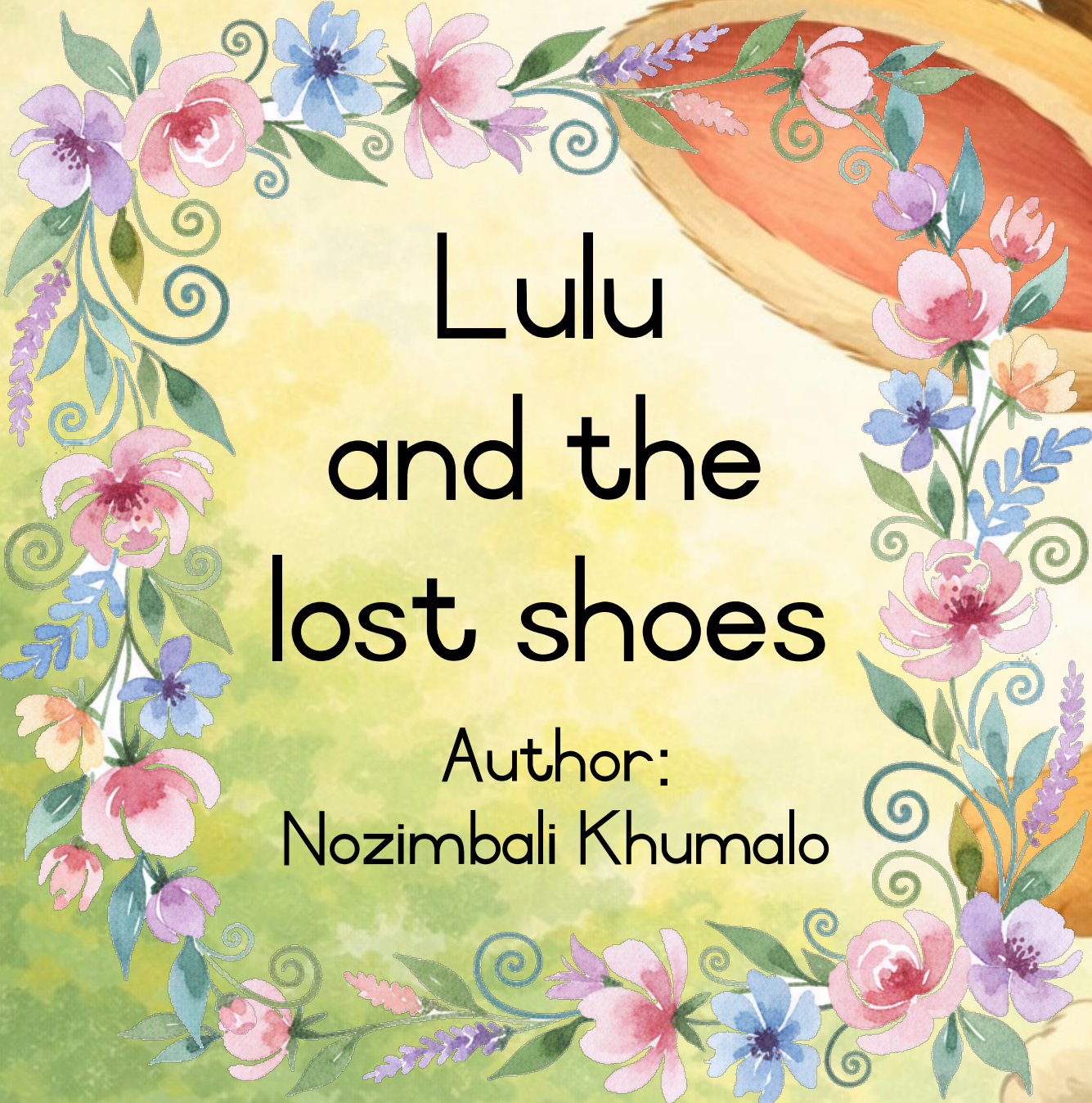




Lulu and the lost shoes

gone!” she cried.



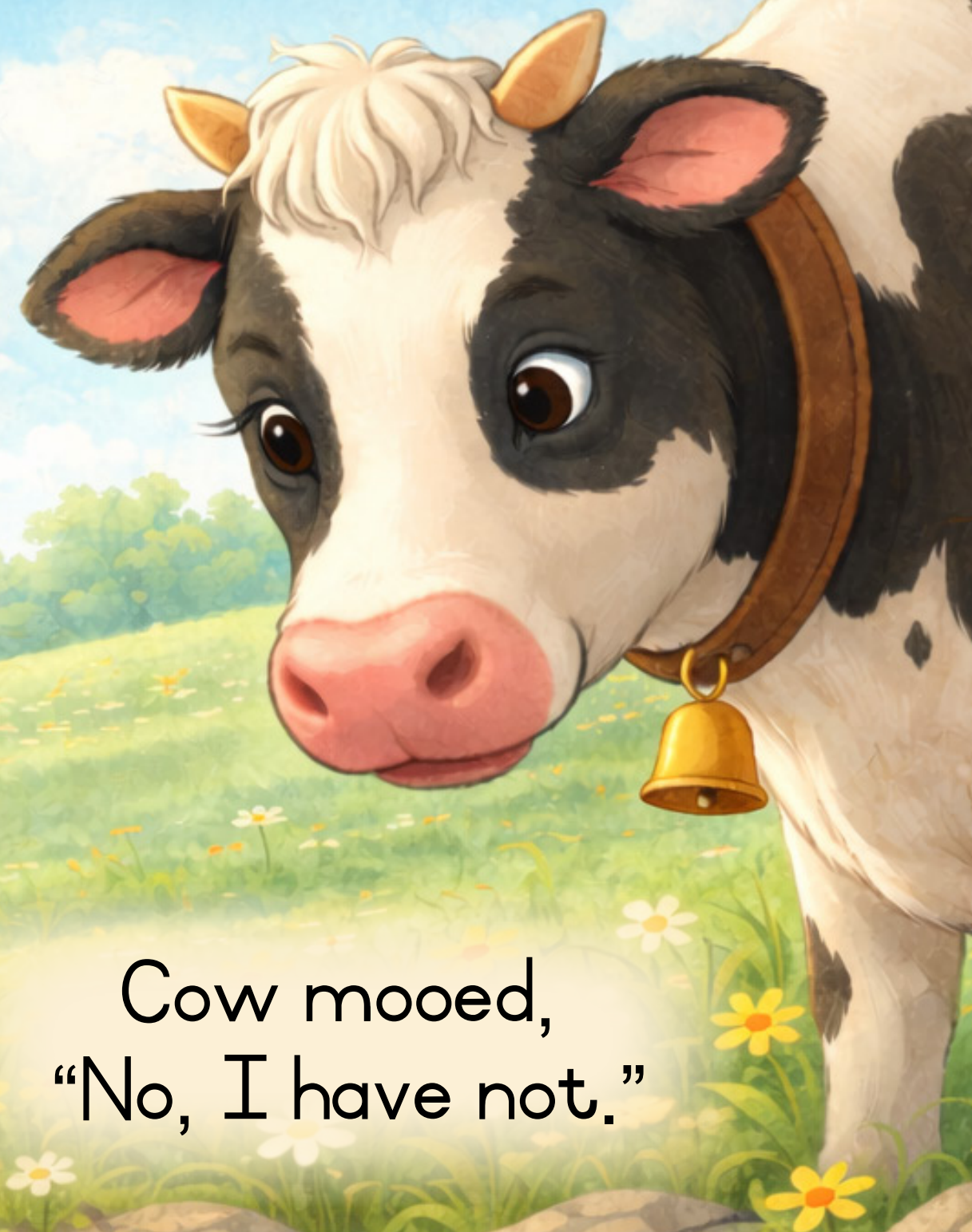


Frog shook his head.
